Over 70% of our students have secured their first or second choice university offers at top institutions or industry-based courses, including apprenticeships. Many students have not only met but exceeded their targets, showcasing inspiring individual success stories across the consortium.

Higher Education progression rates are impressive, with students pursuing a diverse range of courses in STEM, humanities, business, social sciences, and creative industries. Notably, many students have secured places at prestigious Russell Group universities, including Oxford and Cambridge.
